AP STEM AND ENGLISH PROGRAM FACTS

- MIE is partnering with more than 80 middle and high schools in 2015-16.
- MIE leads one of the largest professional development programs for teachers in the region.
- Collectively MIE's partner high schools have more than doubled their AP participation and performance.
- MIE is hosting nearly 300 Saturday Study Sessions for students in 2015-16.
- Of the program's 9,000 students who graduated from high school between 2009 and 2012:
 - 81% enrolled in a two- or four-year college within 16 months of graduating high school;
 - 92% of the students enrolled have persisted in college; and
 - Most importantly, 90% of low-income students are persisting in college.
- 600+ teachers attended MIE's two-week Summer Institute in July 2015.
- 600+ teachers attended workshops MIE's two-day workshops on math, science and English in October 2015.
